

SAS named to the Triangle's best workplaces list

Employee surveys and benefits put SAS high on list

Triangle Business Journal (TBJ) has named SAS as one of the Best Places to Work in North Carolina's Research Triangle Park area (the Triangle). The award selection was based on employee survey results gathered from 173 Triangle companies in July. *TBJ* honored 45 companies across three size categories – Small (50 workers or fewer), Mid-Size (51-150 workers) and Large (151 workers or more).

"It's always gratifying to see our efforts recognized," said Jenn Mann, SAS Vice President of Human Resources. "SAS frequently makes 'best places to work' lists in countries all over the world, but it's especially nice to be honored in our hometown. The fact that this award is based on a survey of our employees makes the recognition even more valuable."
