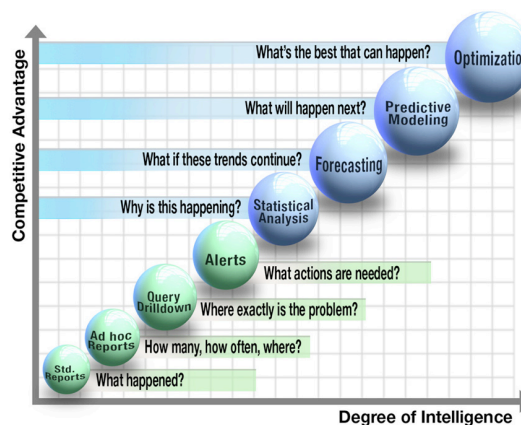

Program performance management

Keeping complex programs on track: A large agency restructured its enterprise to strengthen procurement and contracting and optimize the management of a \$27 billion investment portfolio that includes eight programs and more than 20 major projects. Fraud detection and prevention
