Travel from Canada

- Air Canada flies from Toronto to Seattle and Vancouver (non-stops available for both), as well as to Victoria.
- Westjet flies to Vancouver, Victoria, and Abbotsford from either Toronto or Hamilton.
- United advertises non-stop service from Toronto – it's actually a code-share with Air Canada.
- Several U.S.-based airlines fly from Toronto to Seattle with layovers in a U.S. hub city. The same is true with departures from Buffalo.

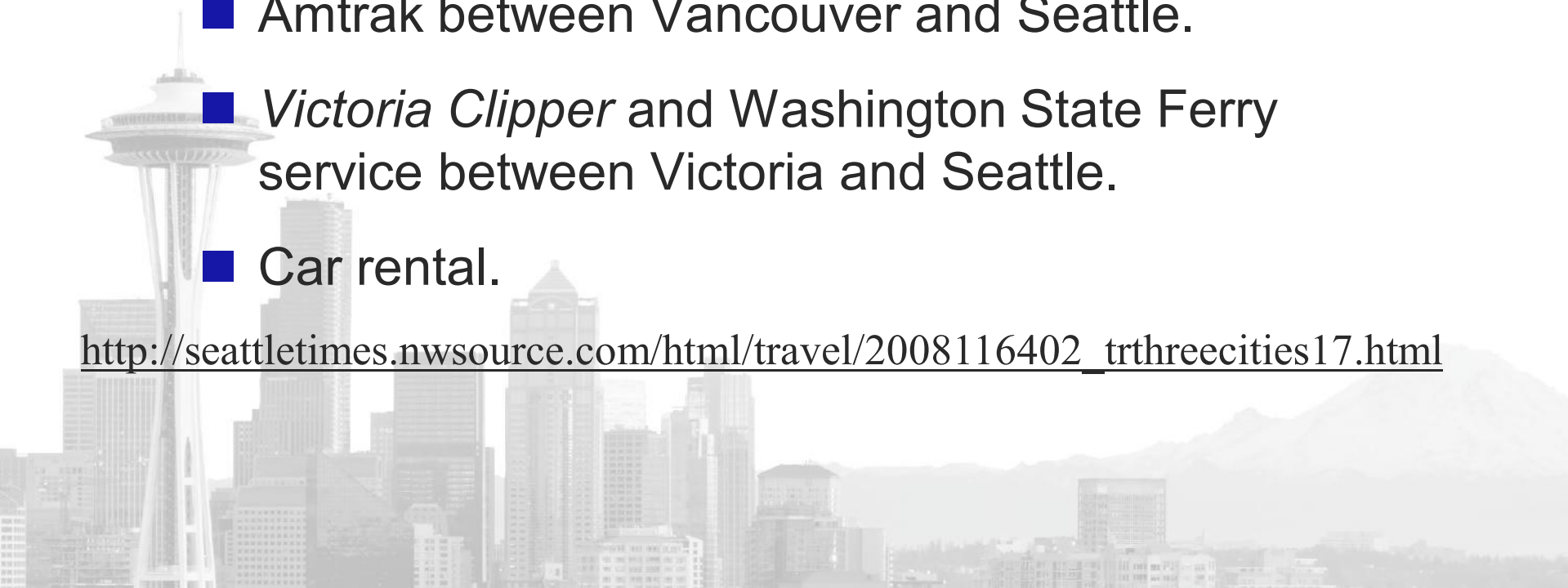




Travel from Canada
