**Abstract** – The Bio21: Molecular Medicine Informatics Model (MMIM) at the Royal Melbourne Hospital continues to evolve. Last year at SMUG we took a close look at Enterprise Guide and its use in this project. This year we plan to continue to monitor the progress of this exciting project.

Recently the MMIM project team has broadened its use of the SAS BI platform to include SAS' web based reporting and distribution capabilities. This has also coincided with an upgrade to the SAS Enterprise Business Intelligence Server.

We will demonstrate how this added functionality is delivered to the users as well as discuss some of the advantages this upgrade confers.

The talk will briefly provide some background to MMIM, its uses and how it will evolve in the future. However, most of the session will be a demonstration of how EBI facilitates report preparation and dissemination as we connect live to the MIMM system!
