Welcome to SAS Learning Edition 4.1

System Requirements Microsoft Windows 2000 or XP Professional (Not supported on any Microsoft Vista Operating System)
1,080 MB hard disk space
256 MB RAM minimum, 512 MB RAM recommended

SAS Learning Edition works with data sets of any size, but it processes and displays only the first 1,500 observations (rows) of your data set in the output. SAS Learning Edition does handle an unlimited number of variables (columns).

SAS Learning Edition 4.1 was tested and is supported on Microsoft Windows 2000 and XP Professional only. In addition, the product was minimally tested to coexist with Base SAS® 8.2 and Base SAS® 9.1.3 Service Pack 4 when SAS Learning Edition 4.1 was installed after Base SAS. Limited support will be provided only when these products are installed in this order. Reinstallation of software might be required if either SAS Learning Edition or Base SAS is removed inappropriately.

Administrator rights: In order to install the program end ensure that the SAS® System is correctly installed it is recommended that you have administrator rights to the computer.

Close all open programs: It is recommended to shut down all open programs, before your start the installation

Antivirus program: Deactivate your anti-virus program, during installation. Please remember to activate you're anti-virus program again, when you have finished the installation of SAS Learning Edition 4.1 if it is not activated automatically.

Installation

To start the SAS Learning Edition installation process, complete the following steps:

- A. Close all non-essential applications. **Be sure to terminate any anti-virus software that you might be running.**
- B. Insert the CD labelled **Setup Disk** into your CD drive.
 1. The Choose Setup Language dialog box should appear. If it does not run, run the <source_drive>:\setup.exe program on the CD.
 2. In the Chose Setup Language dialog box, select the appropriate language, and click the [OK] button.
 3. The SAS Learning Edition auto play window will be displayed.
 4. Click **1. Verify System Requirements** to ensure that your machine meets all of the requirements for SAS Learning Edition. Follow the instructions within the System Requirements Wizard to determine if any of the requirements are not met and to install needed requirements.
 - a) At the **System Update Finished** or **System Update Not Required** screen click the [Finish] button.
 5. Click **2. Install SAS Learning Edition**. Follow the instructions within the SAS Learning Edition Setup Wizard to install the product.
 - a) When you are prompted to **Please insert the disk labelled: Software Disk 2**, remove the first CD from the CD drive, insert the second CD into the drive, and then click [OK].
 - If any auto play dialog box is displayed, then click Cancel.
 - If another dialog box or window is displayed, then click the [X] button in the top-right corner to close it.
 - b) In the Confirm Update dialog box, select the **Use this response for all file types** check box and click [Yes] button.
 - c) When you are prompted to **Please insert the disk labelled: Setup Disk**, remove the second CD from the CD drive, re-insert the first CD into the drive, and then click [OK].
 - d) At the SAS Learning Edition Setup Complete screen, click the [Finish] button.
 - e) When the SAS Learning Edition auto play window is displayed, click the [X] button in the top-right corner to close this window.
 6. Depending on the capability and speed of the computer on which you are installing SAS Learning Edition, this process could take up to 30 minutes to complete.
