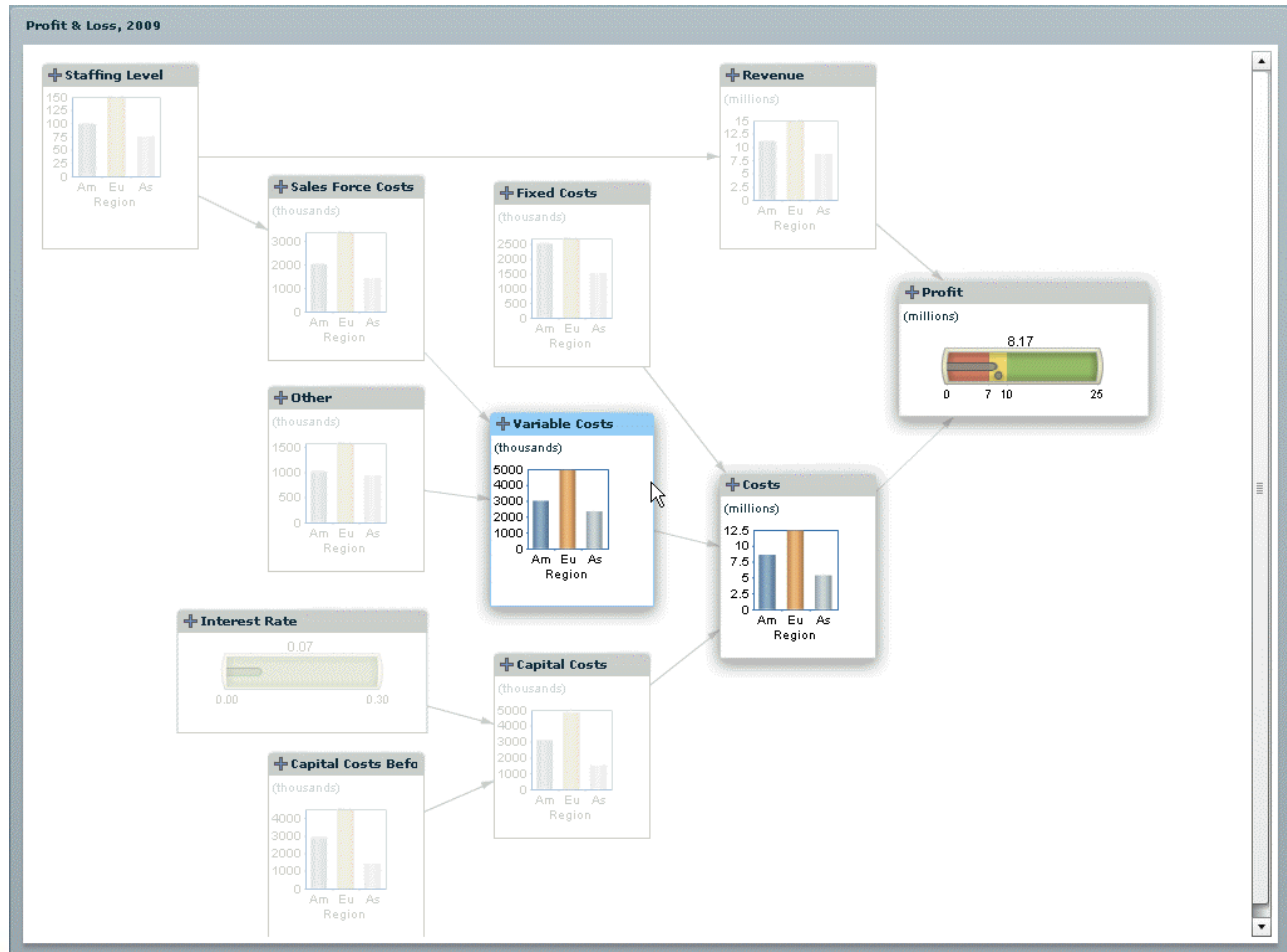

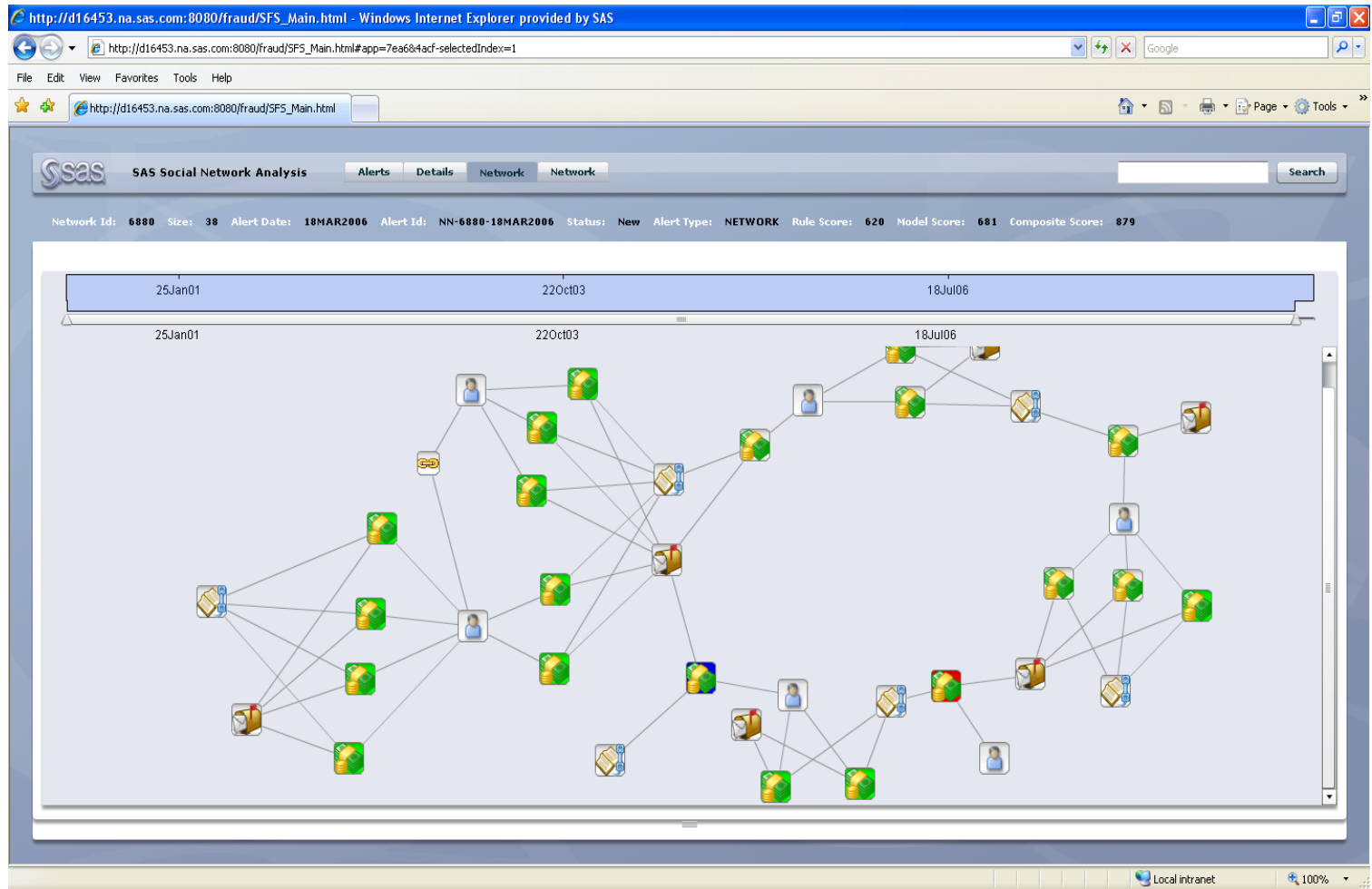

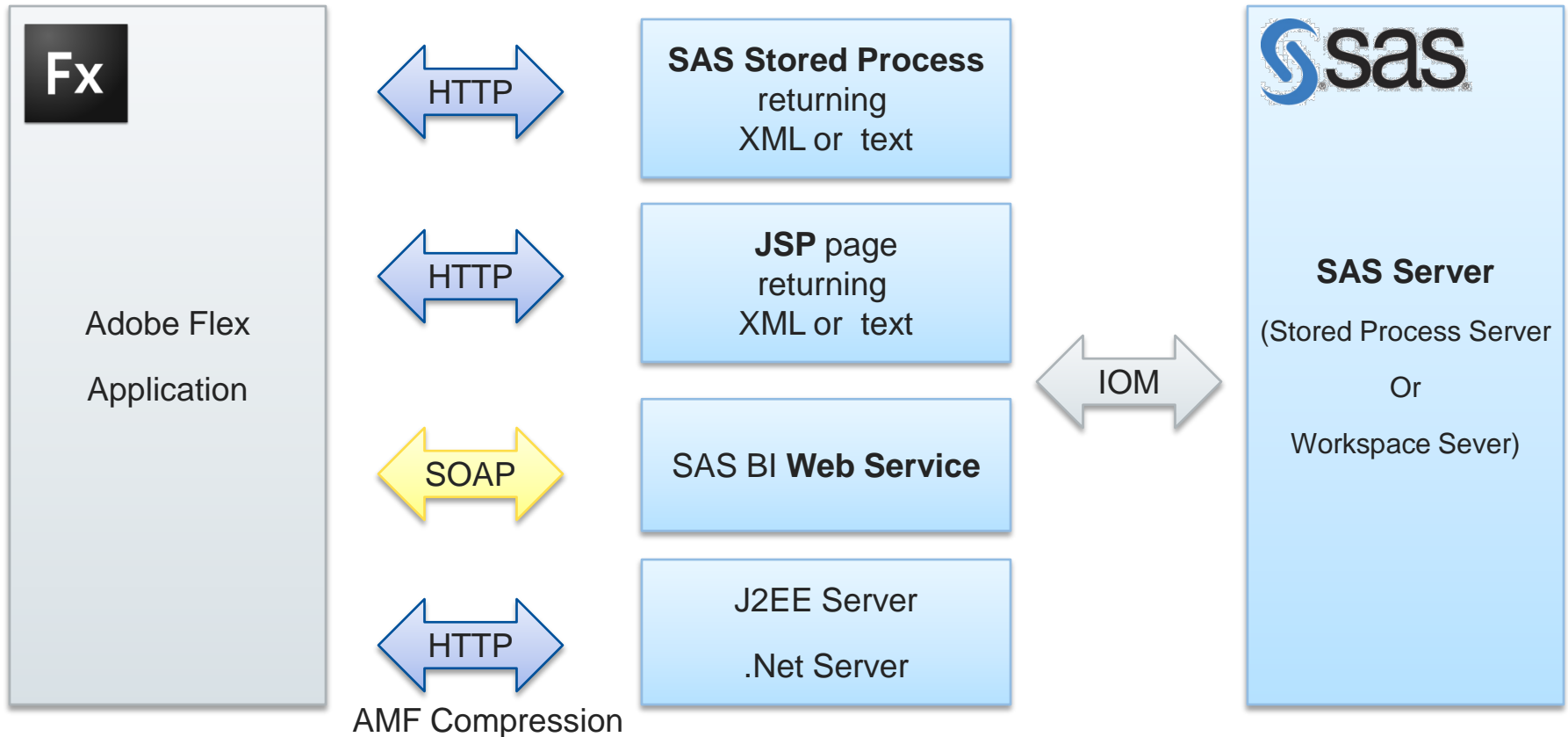

Interoperability between SAS & Flex

In order to use Flex and SAS together, a Flex application has the following options in accessing SAS intelligence:

- Accessing SAS via **HTTP**
 - SAS Stored Processes
 - JSP/ Servlets
- Accessing SAS via **Web Services**
- Accessing SAS via direct **Java method calls**
