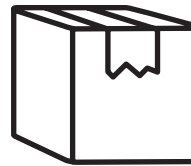


# Cardboard Boats

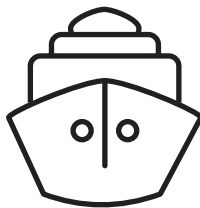
At camp we build these throughout the week and “set sail” Friday in the pool to see which boats are sailable. We build our boats large enough that a camper can sit in them. For your home boats, build them so they can fit in your bathtub.

## Gather materials:

All you need is cardboard, scissors, and duct tape. To make it more challenging, limit the amount of duct tape you can use.



Build a boat - don't forget to give it a name!  
Parental supervision is advised if kids want to cut the cardboard.



Set sail! Try it out in the bathtub or kiddie pool.  
Will it float? How much can it hold?  
Try putting Legos, toy cars, Barbies, etc. in the boat.
