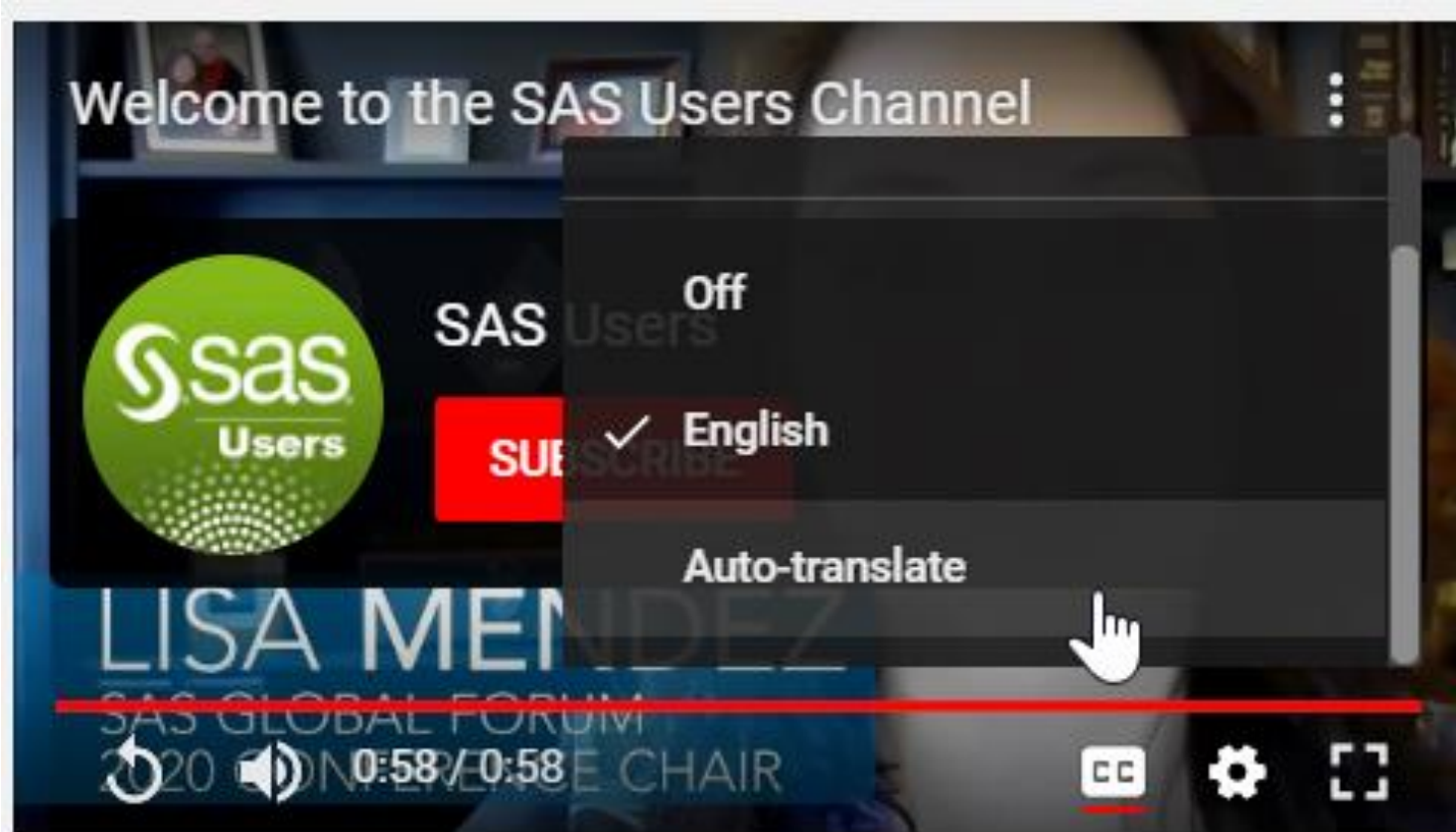
Select “Subtitles/CC”

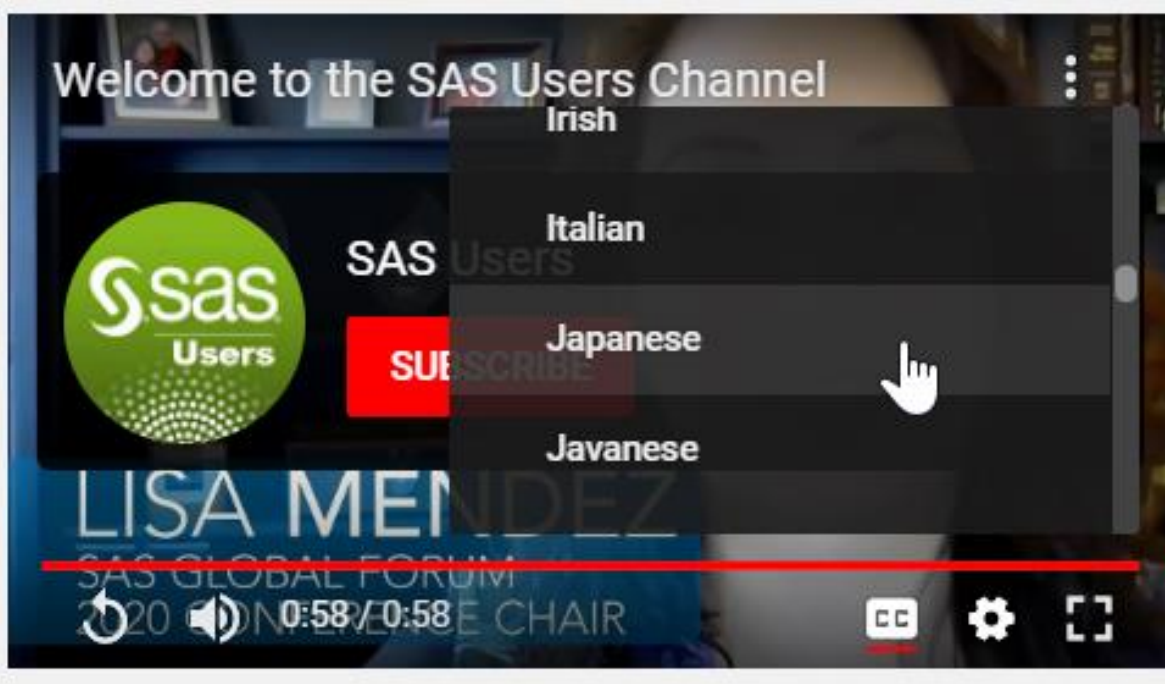
